



# Concert Attire

...WHAT do I wear to concerts????

All Band Students will purchase a Discovery Bands Polo-style shirt (through Mr. Whitlock). Each Band will have a different colored shirt. The polo-style shirt, with the Discovery Band logo embroidered on the upper left chest, is \$15 (fifteen dollars). We have used this dress code before and I think it is very effective for uniformity at concerts, identification on trips or during school assemblies, etc.

## *What You Wear On TOP:*

### ALL BANDS:

**BLACK** Band Polo

All-White T-shirt underneath (no print)

Bottom button **BUTTONED**

*Band Polo shirts will be ordered through Mr. Whitlock. This formal concert dress code is for all concerts and remains in effect for the entire year.*

## *What You Wear On BOTTOM:*

- **TUCK IN your shirt(s)** (tuck in ALL THE WAY AROUND)
- **Nice All-Black Dress Pants:** loose-fitting, no holes, no pinstripes, no low-riders, no hip-huggers, full-length pant legs (no gauchos, capris, etc.), **with a black belt.**
- **All-Black Socks:** you must wear socks, no flesh-tone, no crazy colors, just all black
- **All-Black Shoes:** no open toes, no sandals, no high heels, no tennis shoes/sneakers, and no other color of any kind on the all-black shoes; you'll be standing in these shoes for a long time, so think about COMFORT over fashion when you buy them – they all look the same from the stage anyway. Please, see Mr. Whitlock for any help.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What if I don't have these clothes? *This is why I'm telling you far in advance. You will need to purchase them.* What if I can't afford it? *See Mr. Whitlock privately.* Can I wear a skirt? *No.* Can I wear gauchos? *No.* Can I wear black jeans? *No.* Do I have to wear a white T-shirt under my polo? *Yes.* Do I have to tuck in my shirt(s)? *Yes.* What if I show up in the wrong uniform? *You may not be allowed to perform and your grade will be lowered.* Can I wear flip-flops? *No.* Can I wear black tennis-shoes of any kind? *No.* Can I wear navy blue, dark brown, or gray? *No.* These are frequently asked questions but if you have others please let me know.
